<Note 1> "E2" (a letter of the alphabet & a number) indicates the location of a facility/tree/panel on the sightseeing guide map, "Welcome to Hiroshima."

<Note 2> Shaded-in items (No. 1)-(No. 7) are the facilities listed on the back.

<Note 3> "<Tree>" indicates A-bombed trees, and "<Panel>" indicates an explanatory plaque of damage from the atomic bombing. A-bombed trees have yellow plates hung on their trunks.

<Note 4> Each indicated amount of time includes the time necessary for moving from one facility to the other, for finding the A-bombed trees, and reading the explanatory panels.
