Special Payment System of National Pension Premiums for Students

20歳以上の学生の国民年金保険料後払い制度(P6)

For national pension premiums, there is a special payment deferral system for students having financial difficulties paying their pension payments. Consult with your local ward office (*Hoken Nenkin Ka* (National Insurance & Pension Division)) or branch office if you are having such difficulties.

WHO: Students of universities, colleges, graduate schools, high schools, or vocational schools, whose income is less than a certain amount (1180,000 yen/year if you have no dependents)

TO APPLY: Go to your local ward office or branch office with your *Nenkin Techo* (pension book), your personal seal (*inkan*)* and Student ID. *Personal seal (*inkan*) is exempt if the applicant signs the application.

Publicly Funded Fertility Treatment Access is Expanded

特定不妊治療費の助成内容を拡充します(『市民と市政』2017.4.1号 P3)

The City provides financial support for couples who are having difficulties in getting pregnant and have or will undergo fertility treatment. From April 2017, the number of the publicly funded treatment cycle has been increased from maximum 6 cycles per lifetime to 6 cycles per birth. A couple who has a child through the publicly funded treatment and starts the treatment for their second or further children from April 1, 2017 has become eligible for up to 6 cycles per child birth regardless that they have children as a result of the previously funded treatment. ELIGIBILITY: Those who meet the following conditions:

- A couple whose marriage is legally recorded when they start the treatment.
- At least one person of the couple (wife or husband) is a resident of Hiroshima City.
- A couple who has been diagnosed by a physician with infertility and needs in vitro fertilization or micro fertilization treatment.
- A couple who undergoes in vitro fertilization or micro fertilization treatment in one of the following designated clinics/hospitals.
- Couples whose total income is less than 7,300,000 yen/year.
- The woman of the couple is 42 years old or younger when they start the treatment.

SUBSIDIES:

- Up to 6 cycles of the treatment per birth if the woman is 39 years old or younger on the first day of the treatment
- Up to 3 cycles of the treatment per birth if the woman is 40, 41 or 42 years old on the first day of the treatment
- Up to 150,000 yen per cycle of the treatment (75,000 yen depending on the treatment)
