

漬物 Tsukémono

In line with the ancient need to preserve vegetables, Japan has developed a huge variety of pickles, generally called *tsukémono*. The difference from Western pickles is that they are an essential part of any traditional Japanese meal to accompany plain white rice and soup. Most *izakaya* pubs offer a mixed dish of *tsukémono*.

One traditional way of pickling is to use a large tub (*tsukémono-daru*) with a heavy stone weight on top. In the case of *hakusai-zuké*, for example, the stone presses down on several layers of Chinese cabbage, salt and *tôgarashi* (red peppers).

Here are the seven basic types of pickling, with examples of popular pickles:

- Shiozuké (salt): umeboshi (Japanese apricots) and hakusai (Chinese cabbage)
- **2** Misozuké (miso and saké): garlic, vegetables such as gobô (burdock), fish and meat mostly pork and beef.
- 3 Suzuké (vinegar): rakkyô (scallions)
- Kasuzuké (saké lees, shôchû and sugar): narazuké, a famous type of pickle from Nara city that takes a long time to produce but also lasts a long time.
- **S** Kôjizuké (kôji rice mold): bettarazuké (radish)
- Shoyuzuké (soy sauce and mirin): fukujnzuké (radish and cucumber), which is always served with curry rice (Japanese-style curry).
- **O** Nukazuké (rice bran): takuan (radish), nasu (eggplant), kyûri (cucumber), etc. Nukazuké is made using a pickling medium of fermented rice bran and brine called nukadoko, which is used for several years and gives a special flavor to the pickles of each household. Over a period of a few months, the mixture must be turned over at least once a day. (Abstracted from 『「日本の衣食住」まるごと事典』 p.p. 195-197, IBC パブリッシング)

Pickled vegetables vary with the seasons. From June to July, it is the best season to make *umeboshi* and *rakkyô*. You can buy ready-made *tsukémono* easily when you go to a supermarket, so why not try Japanese *tsukémono* culture?

National Health Insurance for Fiscal Year 2016

平成 28 年度国民健康保険料 保険料率が決まりました(P3)

Kokumin Kenko Hoken

The National Health Insurance (NHI) (国民 健康 保険) premium for fiscal year 2016 has been decided and the payment notice and leaflet will be sent to applicable residents of Hiroshima City on Friday, June 10.

The NHI is one of the health insurance programs available in Japan. It is supported by insurance premiums paid by NHI members and, in turn, pays for a portion of members' medical treatments. Residents of Hiroshima City are required to join the NHI unless they are Long-Term Care Insurance System members or receive health insurance from their employers. The head of household is responsible for the payment of the premiums, which are calculated every year based on household income and the number of household members.

For households in which NHI premiums have greatly increased due to the new calculation method introduced in fiscal year 2014, supportive measures to reduce premiums have been and will continue to be in place until fiscal year 2017. 





Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines for the 2016 fiscal year", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls. The Handbook and Guidelines are translated into English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese and Korean. These are also available at the International Exchange Lounge (International Conference Center Hiroshima), so please ask the staff if you need them.
