Garbage Collection on January 9

1月9日(祝·月)の家庭ゴミの収集(P4)

Although January 9 is a national holiday, household waste will be collected as scheduled.

In January, collection days for recyclable garbage, toxic garbage, plastics other than recyclable plastics, and incombustible garbage might fall on dates different from the usual schedule in some _Katei GomiShushuNittei-hyo

areas. Please check the schedule on the 「家庭ゴミ 収集 日程表 」(Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines), which has been distributed to each household.

Burning garbage at home should be avoided, because it produces smells, smoke and soot which cause annoyances to neighbors. Please note that burning garbage at home is illegal in principal.

Please apply at the *Hoken Fukushi Ka* (Health Services & Welfare Division) of the ward office where the school you want your child to attend is located, between Monday, February 13 and Monday, February 20. *Hoken Fukushi Ka* offices will be open from 8:30 am to 5:00 pm from Monday to Friday.

TEMPORARY EXTENDED HOURS:

Hoken Fukushi Ka will accept applications until 8:00 pm on Wednesday, February 15.

APPLICATION ACCEPTANCE PERIOD FOR 2017 MARCH ENROLLMENT:

For those who want their child to attend a nursery school beginning in March, applications must be submitted by the 1st application acceptance period deadline of Tuesday, January 10.

In general, anyone who lives in Japan, is over 20 and younger than 60 years old, must enroll in the KokuminNenkin

National Pension Plan(国民 年金). Even if you are a student you must join the plan. There are some support systems for those who have trouble paying the premiums because of economic reasons. These systems include pay-later plans for students or youth, and partial or total exemption from premiums for others. For details, please consult one of the following divisions.
