Hiroshima Station Tourist Information Center Re-opened


広島駅総合案内所がリニューアルオープンしました!(P1)

Subsidies for seasonal influenza vaccination will be provided for eligible senior citizens. **ELIGIBILITY:**

 Ÿ People who are 65 or older Ÿ People who are 60 to 64 with physical disabilities including heart, kidney or respiratory diseases classified as Physical Disability Certificate Level 1. 	¥1,600 for one dose (Only available once)
People who meet one of the above conditions and who receive public welfare payments or exemption of income based municipal tax NOTE: You need to bring documents showing you receive public welfare payments (<i>Hihogosha shomeisho</i>) or a Municipal tax charge record certificate (<i>Shi kenmin zei kazei daicho kisaijiko shomeisho</i>).	Free
