

#### Bonsai 盆栽

The painstaking ancient art of *bonsai* (tray-planting) involves the cultivation of miniature potted trees based on the spirit of *shin-zen-bi* (truth, goodness, beauty). It is an interesting combination of manipulating nature while encouraging an appreciation of nature itself. *Bonsai* can often be seen displayed outside people's houses, as well as in the *tokonoma* (a recessed alcove in a Japanese-style guest room) or *genkan* (porch) and at exhibitions. The idea is to create dwarf versions of normal trees – particularly *matsu* (pine), *keyaki* (zelkova), *sugi* (cedar), *momiji* (maple), *sakura* (cherry) and *hinoki* (cypress) – while maintaining proper proportions with the container, a pleasing asymmetry, and a totally 'natural' look. *Bonsai* can live for hundreds of years (Abstracted from <sup>Pr</sup> 日本の衣食住」まるごと辞典』 pp. 29-31, IBC パブリッシング).

Apparently, the custom of admiring potted plants goes back to Nara (A. D. 710-794) and Heian (A. D. 794-1184) times, and something like the *bonsai* we have today appeared in the Kamakura period (A. D. 1185-1333). During the Edo period (A. D. 1603-1868), unusually shaped *bonsai* were most popular, but since the Meiji period (A. D. 1869-1912) tastes have shifted to the cultivation of a natural appearance.

Omiya Bonsai Village, Saitama Prefecture is known as one of the best areas in Japan for cultivating *bonsai*. Many *bonsai*-lovers visit this place not only from all over Japan but from overseas as well.

October is the season during which chrysanthemum exhibitions are held in many places in Japan. In Hiroshima City, the exhibition at Hiroshima Castle is the biggest. Various types of chrysanthemum *bonsais* will be displayed at the exhibition. Please take this chance to see the small but deep "world of *bonsai*". Hiro Club News No. 272





The International Exchange Lounge collects used stamps to assist international cooperation activities. Through the volunteer groups, JOCS\*, the collected stamps are sold to collectors to raise money. With the profit, items such as milk and medicine are purchased and doctors as well as nurses are dispatched throughout Asia and other continents. We also collects PET bottle caps in order to support the "Ecocap Action". The sales profits obtained by recycling caps are donated to the Japan Committee "Vaccines for the World's Children" (JCV).

#### HOW TO COLLECT:

- © Stamps To When you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- © PET Bottle Caps To Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.


## Trio-Phone Service (Multilingual Interpretation over the Telephone)

## **Garbage Disposal Information**

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines for the 2017 fiscal year", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls. The Handbook and Guidelines are translated into English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese and Korean. These are also available at the International Exchange Lounge (International Conference Center Hiroshima), so please ask the staff if you need them.
