### Kagami mochi 鏡もち

Mochi, Japanese rice cakes, are a major feature of New Year cuisine, and are regarded as having a celebratory touch; the sound of 'mochi' suggests another word meaning 'long-lasting'. When it became normal to construct tokonoma alcoves in houses in the Muromachi Period (A. D. 1336-1573), the custom of placing a display of mochi in the tokonoma alcove as an osonae (=offering to the unseen), and a prayer for good fortune began.

Nowadays, two round *kagami mochi* (=mirror rice cakes) with flat bottoms are placed on top of each other. The display usually includes some *konbu* kelp, a *dai dai* bitter orange or a *mi kan* (mandarin), *urajiro* fern leaves, and a skewer of dried *kaki* persimmons. They are all placed on a plain wooden *sanpo* stand with a sheet of white paper beneath it. (Abstracted from 『ニッポン風物詩』 pp. 246-249, IBC パブリッシング).

There's an old belief that at the end of the year, the 'Year God', *Toshigami*, visits every house. The deity is worshipped with this offering of rice cakes. However, recently people aren't so aware of this aspect. They just consider it part of New Year's decorations.

Kagami bi raki Day is a ceremony held on January 11 in which kagami mochi is taken down and eaten. Because it is taboo to cut kagami mochi with a knife, the rice cakes are cracked by hand or split with a mallet, then eaten in soup  $(z\hat{o}ni)$  and in a sweet redbean porridge  $(shi \, ruko)$

#### Be Ready for Earthquakes

<u>いざという時に身を守るために 地震に備えましょう(「市民と市政」2017.11.1 P2)</u>

Earthquakes are sudden disasters that strike without warning. Learn what to do to keep yourself safe. Japan is at a very high risk of earthquakes. Approximately 10% of earthquakes in the world happen in Japan. Earthquakes including the Nankai Trough megathrust earthquakes can happen at any time.

During the earthquake,

- 1. Drop to the ground, and stay as low to the ground as possible.
- 2. Cover your body and head. Get under a table or desk.
- 3. Hold on until the shaking stops.

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#### **Norovirus Food Poisoning Warning!**

冬に流行する食中毒があります ノロウイルスにご注意を(『市民と市政』2017.11.15 P2)

In the winter season, the risk of food poisoning caused by the norovirus increases, and children and seniors whose immune systems are weaker need to be especially careful.

#### WHAT IS THE NOROVIRUS?

You can catch it by eating contaminated foods prepared with contaminated hands or undercooked bivalve shellfish, and also through contact with someone with the virus.

Symptoms usually include vomiting, diarrhea and/or fevers, which appear in 24 to 48 hours (one to two days) after ingesting the virus and last one to two days. Patients usually recover in a couple of days without subsequent complications. Sometimes, those infected may have no symptoms and can infect others without knowing.

Infected persons may infect others by spreading the virus via feces or vomit up to 1 to 4 weeks after recovery.

There are no medicines available that treat norovirus infection. If you are infected, drink plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration, and get enough nutrition, but if the symptoms are severe, seek medical advice.

Cleaning the patient's vomit and feces up requires precaution. It is highly recommended you use disposable surgical masks, rubber gloves and chlorinated disinfectant cleanser. It should be done as soon as possible before drying-up as norovirus can be carried out by aerosols and cause air-borne infection.

#### **TIPS TO PREVENT**

#### 1. Wash your hands thoroughly.

Wash your hands thoroughly with soap, particularly before eating and preparing food and after using the toilet. (Don't rely on alcohol hand gels, as they do not kill the virus.)



#### 2. Eat well-cooked foods.

Cook foods well. Be careful especially of bivalve shellfish. Wash cooking utensils used for raw bivalve shellfish well.

#### 3. Keep cooking utensils clean.

Wash cooking utensils, tablecloths and dish towels well. Chlorinated disinfectant cleanser and boiling sterilization are effective.





## Assisting with International Cooperation with Used Stamps & PET Bottle Caps

#### **HOW TO COLLECT:**

- © **Stamps** Twhen you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- © PET Bottle Caps To Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.


## Trio-Phone Service (Multilingual Interpretation over the Telephone)

## Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines for the 2017 fiscal year", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls. The Handbook and Guidelines are translated into English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese and Korean. These are also available at the International Exchange Lounge (International Conference Center Hiroshima), so please ask the staff if you need them.
