



Umeboshi (pickled plums): 梅干し

Umeboshi are plums pickled in salt. The red color comes from the *shiso* leaves that are pickled along with them.

Umeboshi are a popular and healthy addition to the diet. They increase the appetite, contain citric acid that helps with recovery from fatigue, and they are bactericidal and detoxifying. But although *umeboshi* are good for you if consumed in small quantities, beware of eating too many at one time, especially the small, hard red ones; they contain so much salt, that they can damage your kidneys.

Umeboshi's common uses are: inserted in rice-balls (onigiri); eaten with rice gruel (kayu); and placed in the center of a bed of white rice in a box-lunch to resemble the Japanese flag (hinomaru bento). They can also be added to hot shōchu liquor or bancha green tea. (Abstracted from 『「日本の衣食住」まるごと事典』,pp192-195,IBCパブリッシング). Umeboshi go well with rice, so besides eating them whole, we mash them and use them in dressings or as a flavoring for other foods.

Early summer (June – July) is the best season to make *umeboshi*. *Umeboshi*-making requires great care so in recent years most people buy them at shops. However, *umeboshi*-making is traditional seasonal work in Japan and there are still many people who enjoy this work.

<How to Make Umeboshi>

Green plums are picked in June and soaked overnight in water to remove the bitterness. Then the plums are put in a container with one fourth their weight in salt. A weight is put on top and left for about three days. After the weight is removed, the plums are left to pickle for 3 or 4 weeks and then set out to dry for three sunny days and three nights. *Umeboshi* keep for a long time and taste better when they over a year old (Abstracted from <u>The Japanese-English Dictionary for Conversation about Japan</u>, p67, Obunsha).

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National Health Insurance for Fiscal Year 2018

平成 30 年度国民健康保険料 保険料率が決まりました(P3)

The National Health Insurance (NHI) (*Kokumin Kenko Hoken*) premium for fiscal year 2018 has been decided and the payment notice and leaflet will be sent to applicable residents of Hiroshima City on June 11.

The NHI is one of the health insurance programs available in Japan. It is supported by insurance premiums paid by NHI members and, in turn, pays for a portion of members' medical treatments. Residents of Hiroshima City are required to join the NHI unless they are Long-Term Care Insurance System members or receive health insurance from their employers. The head of household is responsible for the payment of the premiums, which are calculated every year based on household income and the number of household members. Food Poisoning Warning

カンピロバクター食中毒にご注意を(P3)

The most common case of food poisoning in this season is the Campylobacter bacteria. As this is the best season to enjoy barbeques outside, the risk of food poisoning is increases. The bacteria can even be present in fresh meat. Learn about this bacteria and avoid food poisoning caused by it.

Even fresh meat can be dangerous

Campylobacter bacteria normally inhabit the intestinal tract of animals such as chickens, pigs and cattle. The bacteria are frequently detected in foods derived from these animals, which are contaminated during processing. Raw and undercooked meat has a high-risk of causing food poisoning.

Even small amounts of the bacteria cause food poisoning. Symptoms such as diarrhea, fever and/or abdominal pain usually occur one to seven days after infection. Children and seniors whose immune systems are weak need to be especially careful.

Tips to prevent food poisoning caused by Campylobacter bacteria

- Cook meat well until the color of the meat has thoroughly changed.
- Do NOT eat any raw or undercooked meat.
- Wash thoroughly and sterilize your hands and cooking utensils, such as chopping boards and kitchen knives that were used to prepare raw meat. When cooking, make sure to keep your cooking utensils for raw meat and eating cutlery separate and do not mix them up.
- Keep any meat separate from greens and other food items that you eat raw.

Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines for the 2017 fiscal year", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls. The Handbook and Guidelines are translated into English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese and Korean. These are also available at the International Exchange Lounge (International Conference Center Hiroshima), so please ask the staff if you need them.
