Meeting hibakusha: learning about the A-bombing from its survivors

Hajimemashite! I'm Mark, the new CIR (Coordinator for International Relations) here at the Peace Culture Foundation. As well as being available in the International Conference Center for a chat, I'll be writing this quarterly column, which is all about ways to get 'connected' here in Hiroshima. *Yoroshiku onegaishimasu!*

Before coming to Hiroshima, an atomic bomb had never felt like something real or personal to me; a photograph of a mushroom cloud taken from afar. However, in various ways Hiroshima has already opened my eyes to the world under that cloud. The Peace Memorial Museum displays chilling photographs and heartbreaking videos of survivor testimonies, and these are made more real by walking the same streets on which the victims walked. However, what has given me even more understanding than exhibitions and photographs has been the opportunity to meet with those who lived through it all.



The A-Bomb survivors, or *hibakusha* (literally 'bombed person'), numbered just under 155,000 in March this year. Among these, a small proportion are 'storytellers' (*kataribe*), who volunteer their time to give their testimonies about the bombings. As the years wear on and more and more *hibakusha* are no longer with us, a new generation of volunteers called 'successors' (*denshousha*) has stepped up to learn and preserve their stories for the future.

In the last few months I have already had the honor of speaking to multiple hibakusha, and I



have found that meeting survivors in the flesh changes how one learns about the bombing in many ways. For one, hearing the ways in which individuals and their families were affected truly bring the horrors of the bombing home. Also, a dialogue with a human being is more interactive than an inanimate museum piece. For example, my American friends had a chance to ask

questions about feelings towards their country. The *hibakusha* themselves were also curious, and asked us questions about our lives here in Hiroshima. We even touched on profound topics like world history and politics. It was a rare opportunity for exchange.

You can listen to talks by successors every day, in both English and Japanese, at the Peace Memorial Museum. There are sit-down chats with *hibakusha* and successors at Hachidori-sha Café on the 6th (in English) and on the 16th and 26th (with a Japanese-English interpreter) of every month.

Even today, the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum receives donations including items left by the deceased; various documents, pictures and photographs depicting the disaster of the atomic bombing, which were preserved by the A-bomb victims and their bereaved families with utmost care. In the last fiscal year (April 2016 – March 2017), 638 items were donated. Of these, 124 items are exhibited in this exhibition.





Assisting with International Cooperation with Used Stamps & PET Bottle Caps

The International Exchange Lounge collects used stamps to assist international cooperation activities. Through the volunteer groups, JOCS*, the collected stamps are sold to collectors to raise money. With the profit, items such as milk and medicine are purchased and doctors as well as nurses are dispatched throughout Asia and other continents. We also collects PET bottle caps in order to support the "Ecocap Action". The sales profits obtained by recycling caps are donated to the Japan Committee "Vaccines for the World's Children" (JCV).

HOW TO COLLECT:

- © Stamps To When you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- © PET Bottle Caps To Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.


Trio-Phone Service (Multilingual Interpretation over the Telephone)

Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30 am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls. The Handbook and Guidelines are translated into English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese and Korean. These are also available at the International Exchange Lounge (International Conference Center Hiroshima), so please ask the staff if you need them.
