Free preschool education program

<u>幼児教育の無償化を実施します(P2)</u>

Starting from October this year, preschool facilities will become free or their fees will be partially waived. This is to reduce the economic burden of preschool education on households with children.

The details will depend on the type of preschool to which your child goes and your child's age. If you are unsure of the type of preschool to which your child goes, you can ask your child's preschool. The following are summaries of the changes for each type of preschool. For details, please confirm with your child's preschool.

Note: Fees such as those for food, transport, and events are not affected by this program. (Those expenses are the responsibility of parents and guardians.)

Kindergartens (yōchien), nursery schools (hoikuen), nintei-kodomoen, etc.

- Ø If your child is in a class for 3 to 5 year olds, you will no longer pay a fee.
- If your child is in a class for 0 to 2 year olds, their fee will be waived only if their household is exempt from municipal residence tax.
- Ø If your child is in a class for 3 year olds in a kindergarten you will no longer pay a fee.
- If your child is in a class for 3 year olds in the kindergarten part of a nintei-kodomoen, you will no longer pay a fee.
- However, if you receive an incentive for attendance (就園奨励費), a maximum of 25,700 yen from each month's fee will be repaid at a later date (see below).

The above also applies to: small daycare facilities (*shōkibo hoiku jigyōsho*), daycare facilities established in business places (*jigyōsho-nai hoiku jigyōsho*), and company-led daycare facilities (*kigyōshudō-gata hoiku jigyōsho*).

Out-of-hours childcare (azukari hoiku) provided by kindergartens (yōchien)

If your child has been recognized as needing childcare, the fee for your child's out-of-hours childcare will be repaid at a later date (see below).

- If your child is in a class for 3 to 5 year olds, depending on their situation, up to 11,300 yen from month's fee will be repaid at a later date (see below), in addition to the fee for normal hours being waived.
- If your child is in a class for 3 year olds, and their household is exempt from municipal residence tax, up to 16,300 yen from each month's fee will be repaid at a later date (see below).

Unauthorized daycare facilities (ninkagai hoiku shisetsu) and similar facilities

If your child has been recognized as needing childcare, but does not go to a facility such as a nursery school or nintei-kodomoen, their fee will be repaid at a later date (see below).

- If your child is of equivalent age to a class for 3 to 5 year olds, up to 37,000 yen from each month's fee will be repaid at a later date (see below).
- If your child is of equivalent age to a class for 0 to 2 year olds, and their household is exempt from municipal residence tax, up to 42,000 yen from each month's fee will be repaid at a later date (see below).

In addition to unauthorized daycare facilities (which include "baby hotels" and babysitters), one-off childcare, childcare for sick children, and Family Support Centers are also in this category.

<u>Note:</u> Only facilities approved by City Hall belong to this category. There are plans to publish the names of approved facilities on the City Hall website.

Preschools for children with disabilities (Shōgaiji Tsūen Shisetsu)

- n If your child is of equivalent age to a class for 3 to 5 year olds, their fee will be waived.
- n If your child also goes to a kindergarten, nursery school or nintei-kodomoen, the fees for that facility will also be waived.

Repayment at a later date (償還 払い)

This means that you will first pay the fee to the relevant facility, but you can later apply to City Hall to have some or all of the fee repaid.

Application procedures

* Nursery schools and nintei-kodomoen

No special procedures are needed.

If you use both the kindergarten part of a nintei-kodomoen and out-of-hours childcare (*azukari hoiku*), the nintei-kodomoen will explain the procedure for recognition to you.

* Kindergartens

Your child's kindergarten will explain what to do.

* Unauthorized daycare facilities (Ninkagai Hoiku Shisetsu)

The application procedure will be explained on the City of Hiroshima website in early August.

* Preschools for children with disabilities (Shōgaiji Tsūen Shisetsu) No special procedures are needed.

National Pension contributions: exemption and deferral

If you struggle to pay your National Pension contributions for financial reasons, you can apply to be exempted from some or all of it, or to have your payment deferred. If you do not pay your contributions and do nothing about it, you may not be able to receive your basic pension in your old age.

HOW TO APPLY:

Bring your pension handbook, inkan seal (and your student I.D. if you are a student), and so on to the National Insurance and Pension Division (Hoken Nenkin Ka) of your local ward office or branch office.







- © Stamps To When you cut stamps from envelopes, please leave 5 mm of paper around them. It is not necessary to remove them from the envelope. Torn or folded stamps cannot be accepted.
- © PET Bottle Caps To Only PET bottle caps for drinks or mineral water are accepted. Please wash the caps and tear off the sticker if it has one. This is in order to avoid damaging the recycling machines. Things such as metal caps and pull-top tabs cannot be accepted.

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30 am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls. The Handbook and Guidelines are translated into English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese and Korean. These are also available at the International Exchange Lounge (International Conference Center Hiroshima), so please ask the staff if you need them.
