He continues to provide emergency medical treatment and mental care to people who suffer from natural disasters and conflicts throughout the world.

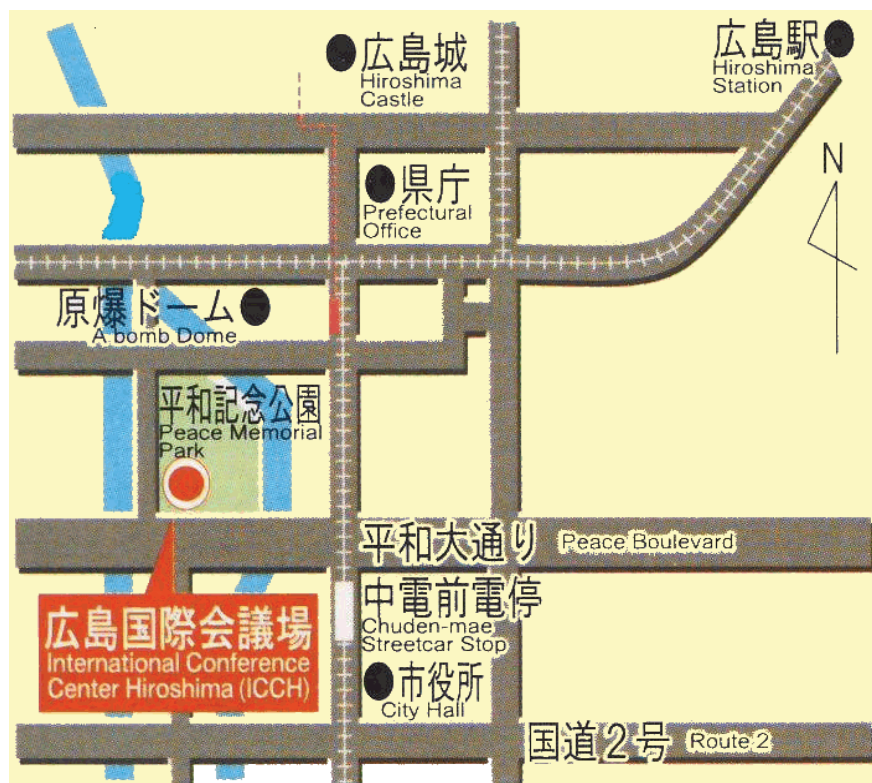
