
Tako (octopus) たこ

Many countries next to the sea have a food culture which includes octopus. In Japan, octopus is one of the important ingredients in Japanese food.

Takoyaki is Japan's most familiar octopus dish. It is a grille-cooked dumpling, consisting of wheat flour, bits of octopus (tako), green onion and ginger (benishoga). Then, it is served topped with sauce, powdered seaweed (aonori) and dried bonito (katsuobushi).

Japanese love octopus the shape as well. "Tako-san Sausage" is a pan-fried sausage carved to look like an octopus. This is a popular ingredient in bento (lunch boxes), especially for children.

Mihara City in Hiroshima Prefecture is a town famous for octopus. There are good marine conditions for octopi to live and grow. You will see many pots to catch octopus (takotsubo) placed alongside the fishery port in Mihara. Also, you can enjoy various octopus dishes as well. As for unique ones, how about octopus baumkuchen and octopus momiji-manju? Momiji-manju, which is Hiroshima's famous confection, is a maple-leaf-shaped cake with filling that is usually sweet bean paste. Octopus momiji-manju's filling is cheese cream and boiled octopus. If you have a chance to go to Mihara, why not try these rare and unique octopus-based foods?





Hiroshima Jyōhō a-Netto:

An Online Treasure Trove of Community Information

A quick search for "Hiroshima Community" on a major search engine yields a regional Craigslist page. Not quite what you imagine when hearing the word, "community," right? If you're looking for sports groups and classes, social clubs, like-minded hobbyist meetings, and more, take a look at the *Hiroshima Jyōhō a-Netto* ("Hiroshima Information 'a-Net'") website: www.a-net.shimin.city.hiroshima.jp

Though the a-Net website is only offered in Japanese, basic knowledge of katakana and hiragana is more than enough to break the surface of all the opportunities on view. If you'd still like some tips on how to navigate the site, read on for a basic run-down!

The options menu at the top of the website is basically the same as the menu on the left- hand side. Clicking on any of the menu tabs, such as the $\prec \sim \gt$ ("Events") tab,

loads a page of more specific options (see image below) so that you can narrow down your search. For the purposes of this rundown, let's say the summer weather has you wanting to see what's on offer at public pools.

After clicking on the 水泳・ウォータースポーツ ("Swimming & Water Sports") link under the "Sports, Recreation" tab, you'll be taken to a full list of related events. Above this list is a map of the different wards within Hiroshima City; clicking on your geographical area of interest will narrow down the events list to only include activities taking place in that ward. For example, selecting Naka-ku Ward will bring up a list of over ten activities, one of which is ホットヨガ ("Hot Yoga"). Let's take a gander!

One click takes you to the activity details. Though there may be slight changes between the information available on different activities, you can generally find a short description of the event, its date(s) and time(s), its location, the target age of participants, cost of participation, and contact information. In the case of this hot yoga activity, it seems you would have to wait a good month until the next scheduled session on August 31st. Whether that inspires disappointment or not depends on your interests, but what's certain is that even if hot yoga's not for you, the Hiroshima Information 'a-Net' has you covered for fun things to enjoy in the city!

If you live at an address that differs from the one on your resident card due to unavoidable circumstances (for example, you have been evacuated from the Great East Japan Earthquake or sheltered from domestic violence), please inform the municipal office where your residence certificate (住民票) is registered of where you want the notice to be sent by submitting the application form to them by Fri., September 25, 2015. Reduction/Exemption of Water and Sewerage Rates

水道料金、下水道使用料の減免制度があります(P5)

WHO:

- 1) Households receiving Seikatsuhogo (生活保護 public welfare payments)
- 2) Households receiving benefits for Japanese war orphans who returned to Japan from China
- 3) Households with a family member who falls within one of the following types of disabilities:
 - (i) Holders of Shintai Shougaisha Techo (身体障害者手帳 Physical disability certificate: levels 1–3); a Ryouiku Techo (療育手帳 Medical rehabilitation certificate: (A), A, (B)); or a Seishin Shougaisha Hoken Fukushi Techo (精神障害者保健福祉手帳 Mental disability public health and welfare certificate: levels 1 or 2)
 - (ii) Those who receive *Tokubetsu Jido Fuyo Teate* (特別児童扶養手当 Special Child Dependent's Allowance), *Shougai Kiso Nenkin* (障害基礎年金 Basic Pension for the Disabled) or *Shougai Nenkin* (障害年金 Pension for the Disabled: levels 1 or 2)
- 4) Households with a family member who is 65 or older and approved for nursing care (levels 4 or 5) by their nursing care insurance (介護保険)
- 5) Single-parent families
- 6) Some social welfare facilities in the private sector

If you or your family member(s) fall under (3) or (4), but are currently hospitalized or institutionalized, you may not be eligible. There is also an income limitation for those who fall within (3), (4) & (5). For details, please consult your local water station (see table below).

DEDUCTION RATE:

0-10 cubic meters will be discounted from your monthly water usage bill. For details, please consult a relevant office (see table below).

APPLICATION:

Bring documents that prove your eligibility along with your *inkan* (name stamp) to your ward's *Suido Kyoku Eigyo Sho* (Water Works Service Station) or *Kosei Bu* (Public Welfare Department).







Garbage Disposal Information

Separate garbage properly and take it to the collection site by 8:30am on the designated day. Please do NOT take garbage to the site on the night before. Garbage collection days vary depending on where you live and the category of the refuse. For further details, consult your local ward office or your neighbors to be sure of the proper disposal method. "Hiroshima 8", a handbook on how to separate garbage, and "Hiroshima City Garbage Disposal Guidelines for the 2015 fiscal year", a garbage chart with schedules of garbage collection days, are available at ward offices, branch offices and community halls. The Handbook and Guidelines are translated into English, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese and Korean. These are also available at the International Exchange Lounge (International Conference Center Hiroshima), so please ask the staff if you need them.
